 - Gradual growth/expansion based on added value to the programme.



























GROWTH: START IN 2010 (LONG TIME AGO)










2013: UQ joins as Associated Partner








2013: ETH Zürich joins as Associated Partner








2015: UMD joins as Associated Partner








2020: USTC joins as Associated Partner








2021: UPC joins as Associated Partner

- Exceptional employability of graduating students.






















In which geographical region were you located for your first job?










How long after graduation did you find a job within the engineering field?
